When it opens its doors in **July 2017**, Villages Nature Paris will **bridge the gap between the City and Nature**, offering guests from France and around the world **the chance to escape for a break** while also exploring the cultural treasures of the Paris region or experiencing the magic of Disneyland® Paris.

Our employment commitments

Villages Nature Paris will create **nearly 1,000 direct jobs** when it opens (including jobs at partner organisations and subcontractors) and **1,600 indirect jobs**, generated by our guests' spending off-site.

In July 2014 Villages Nature® Paris signed a Jobs Agreement with the French government, the Paris Region, the Seine-et-Marne Department and Pôle Emploi, pledging to make special efforts to recruit candidates from the local area, prioritising the following groups:

- employees looking for transfer opportunities,
- people seeking to enter the workforce,
- and workers who are registered as disabled.

As the destination will be open year round, most of the jobs will be permanent contract positions. These positions will span 60 different job titles ranging from guest services (reception, activities and events, catering, etc.) to support services (maintenance, groundskeeping, housekeeping, security, etc.). The areas with the most jobs available are housekeeping, catering and retail.



A VARIETY OF POSITIONS

Operations positions with significant interaction with the public:

- Reception
- Activities (e.g., kids club instructors, specialised recreational activities)
- Aquatics (e.g., swimming attendants, lifeguards)
- Restaurants & Retail (e.g., all catering roles, shopkeepers and sales assistants, depending on the type of shop)

Operational support positions:

- Security (e.g., security officers)
- Housekeeping (e.g., housekeeping staff, cleaning staff)
- Groundskeeping, including animal care (e.g., general and specialised gardeners)
- Maintenance (e.g., technical and general maintenance staff)

A strong commitment to inclusion of disabled workers

Villages Nature Paris has set a goal of ensuring disabled workers make up 6% of its workforce upon opening, rather than within three years as allowed by law. To support this initiative the destination signed an agreement with AGEFIPH, an association that helps place disabled workers in jobs, in addition to its partnerships with DIRECCTE, Pôle Emploi, the regional and departmental authorities, CAP Emploi, Missions Locales and other key stakeholders in the jobs sector. All positions are open to disabled workers.

The applicant's skills alone will be considered (any need to adapt the workplace will be evaluated). Job descriptions clearly presenting the conditions of suitability for the positions and the capabilities required have been developed so that all candidates can apply with a full understanding of the position.

Operations positions

Reception (49 jobs):

Whether they are service managers, front desk staff or receptionists, they are the first point of contact with our guests. They play an essential role in a good holiday for our guests, welcoming them, providing information and guiding them towards the immersive worlds and activities that will make their stay even more memorable.

Activities (32 jobs):

Our activities staff lend their enthusiasm to our athletic, recreational and creative activities programme. Their goal: to give guests unforgettable experiences while ensuring their safety.

Aquatics (73 jobs):

The only thing our guests should have to worry about is climbing our giant slides or making the next round of beach volleyball. Our aquatics supervisors and lifeguards are responsible for ensuring that the Aqualagon and Beach are safe and comply with hygiene regulations.

Restaurants & Retail (250 jobs approx.):

With 8 restaurants to choose from, including a bistro, an Italian restaurant, a burger shop and several healthy on-the-go options, guests can savour their holiday at their own pace. A small grocery and a bakery round out the offering. From food preparation to cooking and counter service, all our catering staff play an important role in crafting delicious dishes from fresh products to delight our guests. Dishwashers complete the team. Dining room managers, waiters and bartenders attend to diners' every wish. On the retail front, self-service employees, cashiers and sales assistants run our various outlets (food and non-food shops, bike rental centre, etc.) and advise our guests.

Operational support positions

Security (53 jobs):

The security department comprises a security manager (French SSIAP 3 diploma), security and fire safety (SSIAP 2) section heads, security officers (SSIAP 1) and safety officers. It is responsible for the security of people and goods (site safety, fire protection and compliance with sanitation, health and environment regulations).

Our team of housekeepers and cleaning staff keep all of the site's apartments, cottages and facilities clean.

Gardening, Groundskeeping & Animal Care (42 jobs):

Proper care of our vegetation is essential to guaranteeing an excellent guest experience in every season. Not only do our gardeners oversee the care and quality of every plant on the site, they also share their passion and knowledge to inspire our guests to cultivate their own gardens.

Biodiversity and Wildlife Coordinators protect and develop the site's biodiversity, from wetland areas to forest ecosystems, gardens (decorative and vegetable), composting and more.

The Farm Animal Caretaker oversees routine care of the animals (feeding, weighing, training) and keeps the facilities up to standard to meet the animals' physiological needs and ensure their well-being. This employee works with the Activities team to organise educational activities involving the animals for guests.

As part of the partnership between Villages Nature Paris and various public stakeholders (the French government, the Paris Region, the Seine-et-Marne Department and Pôle Emploi), all job openings will be available on Pôle Emploi (http://www.pole-emploi.fr/accueil/), in the dedicated Villages Nature Paris section. Candidates can apply directly by simple creating a personal profile on the website.

The first vacancies for operations positions will be published in mid-December 2016. Starting in January 2017, Villages Nature Paris and Pôle Emploi will organise group information sessions on the jobs that will be offered and the number of openings for each job title.

Some jobs require specific certificates and qualifications. For example, swimming attendants must hold the French BNSSA certificate. However, applicants without the requisite degrees will still be considered, especially for positions such as general cleaning staff, dishwashers, general catering staff, etc.

Villages Nature Paris works closely with France's Public Employment Service to provide **training for positions** at Villages Nature Paris. The training sessions being organised include swimming attendant training, **pre-qualifications** for aquatic positions and **employment training programmes** for general catering staff, prep cooks, general cleaning staff, etc. Most of these training courses are expected to begin in early 2017.

Once hired, employees will receive **job preparation training** and follow an **onboarding programme** that includes general training on the destination concept and sustainable development as well as more job-specific training on, for example, the special features of Villages Nature Paris (Aqualagon, Farm, etc.).



Terms of employment

Schedule:

- December 2016: First round of operations jobs opens, including lifeguards
- January 2017: Remaining operations positions open
- January to April 2017: Group information sessions supported by Pôle Emploi
- April to June 2017: Job preparation training
- Month before destination opens: Employment contracts signed and employees onboarded

Job simulation assessments:

For housekeeping and cleaning positions, Villages Nature Paris intends to use job simulation assessments in order to evaluate candidates in action, without an initial CV screening. This method does not take account of a candidate's degree, qualifications, knowledge or age. It evaluates the transferability of personal skills to professional skills.

Through a series of exercises, it puts candidates in a real work situation to assess their suitability for the desired job. These exercises are an opportunity to observe and evaluate how the applicants tackle and resolve the challenges they encounter on the job. Each candidate performs a range of real-life tasks, either alone or in a group. Candidates must be organised, complete tasks while adhering to standards and instructions and achieve a specific result.

This hiring method has been developed to reduce discrimination while maintaining the high standards of Villages Nature Paris.

Customer service aptitude test:

For all other jobs, customer service aptitude tests will be organised with the support of Pôle Emploi for candidates who meet Villages Nature Paris criteria (experience and, if required, diplomas). It is very important to measure candidates' skills in terms of service-mindedness and hospitality, regardless of their role in the company, as well as their alignment with the values of Villages Nature Paris.



How to apply to Villages Nature Paris

Procedure:

- Consult the job openings on the Pôle Emploi website, on the Villages Nature Paris page (go to www.pole-emploi.fr and select En Région\lle de France\Actus-Agenda\Recrutement Villages Nature), starting in mid-December 2016.
- 2. Create a personal profile and apply for a job.
- **3.** Receive an invitation from Pôle Emploi to attend a Villages Nature Paris group information session starting in January 2017.
- **4.** Take the hospitality aptitude test.

OR

Receive an invitation to take the housekeeping simulation tests.

5. If you pass the tests, you will be included in the hiring process.

Application:

All applications must include a cover letter citing the job reference number and a detailed CV. Every applicant will receive a response. Applications will not be returned.
